Swans are back on the lake, with 3 being counted and photographed after the September survey.

The UK national Red list identifies all species of bird that are considered at risk or endangered in the UK and Europe. Herring Gull, Sparrow, Starling and Song Thrush, sighted in September, are now on this list although in Surrey they currently remain a common sight.
