Action Plan

The Action Plan illustrates an indicative sequence of activities for implementing the projects recommended in the Review document to which reference should be made.

All timescales are estimated and in most cases, will be determined by funding and resource availability. All projects are subject to the approval of relevant stakeholders before being initiated.

The Action Plan also reflects the relative priority of each project and its anticipated duration. For example, enhancement of the Meadow wildflower diversity and abundance will be a long term exercise extending over a number of years during which the success or otherwise of associated actions will be assessed. Other projects represent one-off activities that can be implemented relatively quickly.

Completion of the wildlife surveys is considered essential to provide benchmarks against which the benefits or otherwise of the various measures can be assessed through regular survey updates.
